Meaning has been attached to each component of the 2006 RVing Women Convention Logo.

Early cultures developed the tradition of gathering around a central fire. The oval represents the circle of friends and circling of the wagons.

Although the Sunflower is the state flower, Kansas is known as the Wheat State. Early pioneers came to Kansas in covered wagons, used to transport their families and their belongings. The covered wagon served as the first *home on wheels* and is parked next to a modern day version.

The 2006 Convention will be held in the center of our country, in Hutchinson, Kansas. Attendees from all four directions will travel through varying landscapes and city scapes, across America the Beautiful, to come together in a circle of friendship.
